- * Display racks
- * Booth Lighting
- * Sandbags (wind)
- * Tables/Chairs
- * Dolly for unloading/loading
- * 25 Foot Extension Cord

Rules and Guidelines:

1. All spaces are assigned by AV Fair/Showdown.
2. All canopies and tents are to be flame retardant.
3. All items are required to be sold by and supervised by the service club or staff employed by service group.
4. All set up is to be completed one hour prior to gates open, no exceptions. Vehicles are not permitted on the grounds during the event.
5. Vendors are responsible to set up their own display and clean up their area every evening. Trash bins will be provided on site. **All vendors are required to remain in the area during hours of event.**
6. All signage and decorations must meet Showdown/AV Fair approval.
7. The Showdown Rodeo is an outdoor event that may have inclement weather conditions. The Showdown/AV Fair is not responsible for any damage or theft of any goods, items or vendor display.
8. The Showdown shall have committee personnel at the event site from opening to closing.
9. All vendors shall obtain, at their own expense, licenses and permits required for operation, including but not limited to licenses and permits required by the State of California, the County of Los Angeles, and the Antelope Valley Fairgrounds business license, etc.
10. Vendor agrees to provide all service equipment, supplies and personnel, and to assume complete responsibility for the staffing and operation of their booth.
11. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
12. All Commercial vendors are required to obtain a State Seller's Permit prior to the event and post on site at all times. Vendors failing to comply will be asked to leave the premises without a refund.
13. Pets are not permitted on park grounds.
14. Vendor entry gates and parking shall be posted.

Termination of this agreement: The Showdown Rodeo/AV Fair is an outdoor event and will be conducted rain or shine. The rental fee shall not be refundable due to Vendor's cancellation or failure to appear.
